Notes

1. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or Capital Gains tax at least equal to the tax that Darlington FC Foundation reclaims on your donations in the tax year (currently 25p for each £1 you give).

3. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and Capital Gains equal to the tax that the Foundation reclaims, you can cancel your Declaration (see Note 1) by notifying the Foundation Treasurer.
4. If you pay Income Tax at the higher or additional rate and want to receive the additional tax relief due to you, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self Assessment tax return or ask HM Revenue and Customs to adjust your tax code.
5. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, contact the Foundation Treasurer, or ask your local Tax Office for Leaflet IR65 (also available on the HMRC website).
